

IEEE TCCSE Call for Career Awards

The IEEE **Technical Committee of Cyber Systems and Engineering (TCCSE)** aims to advance the theory, practice, and interdisciplinary aspects of the current intelligent cyber systems and their engineering within the IEEE **Systems, Man, and Cybernetics (SMC)** Society.

The committee solicits nominations of the **Early-Career Award (ECA)**, **Mid-Career Award (MCA)**, and the **Life Career Award (LCA)**. Each award will have a public citation on the IEEE TCCSE website (<https://www.ieeesmc.org/technical-activities/cybernetics/cyber-systems-and-engineering/>):

- **1. IEEE TCCSE Early-Career Award:**

IEEE Early-Career Award (ECA) for Excellence in TC of Cyber Systems and Engineering recognizes one or more junior scientists or engineers who have contributed in an outstanding way to the research in the field of Smart Computing and Intelligent Systems.

Requirements:

1. A nominee shall hold a Ph.D. degree.
2. A nominee shall have contributed to computing and engineering research for over 3 years after obtaining the first Ph.D. degree and no more than 10 years.
3. A nominee shall have a strong academic record proving his/her contribution to the Cyber Systems and Engineering community.
4. Must be an IEEE SMC member (\$9) and IEEE TCCSE member (free, just claim to join), which can be joined at any time.
5. At least two recommendation letters with current CV.

Nomination Materials Submission for ECA:

A nominee or nominator must submit all materials in PDF format to the Chair of IEEE TCCSE via an email (qiumeikang@yahoo.com). Materials should include:

- First name, last name, affiliation, mail address, telephone, email.
- Two recommendation letters.
- Personal statement (up to 500 words, highlight academic achievements).
- A full academic resume (including all academic publications in recent 5 years).
- Anything can prove nominee's research achievements.
- Anything benefits to recruit IEEE TCCSE members.

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- **2. IEEE TCCSE Mid-Career Award:**

IEEE Mid-Career Award (MCA) for Excellence in TC of Cyber Systems and Engineering recognizes one or more senior scientists or engineers who have contributed in an outstanding way to the research in the field of Smart Computing and Intelligent Systems.

Requirements:

1. A nominee shall hold a Ph.D. degree.
2. A nominee shall have contributed to computing and engineering research for over 8 years after obtaining the first Ph.D. degree and no more than 15 years.
3. A nominee shall have an outstanding academic record proving his/her contribution to the Cyber Systems and Engineering community.
4. Must be an IEEE SMC member (\$9) and IEEE TCCSE member (free, just claim to join), which can be joined at any time.
5. At least two recommendation letters with current CV.

Nomination Materials Submission for MCA:

A nominee or nominator must submit all materials in PDF format to the Chair of IEEE SCSTC via an email (qiumeikang@yahoo.com). Materials should include:

- First name, last name, affiliation, mail address, telephone, email.
- Two recommendation letters.
- Personal statement (up to 500 words, highlight academic achievements).
- A full academic resume (including all academic publications in recent 5 years).
- Anything can prove nominee's research achievements.
- Anything benefits to recruit IEEE TCCSE members.

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• 3. IEEE TCCSE Life-Career Award:

The IEEE Life Career Award (LCA) for Excellence in TC of Cyber Systems and Engineering recognizes one or more senior computing scientists or engineers who have an outstanding and significant contribution to the field of Smart Computing and Intelligent Systems.

Requirements:

1. A nominee shall have contributed to computing and engineering research for over 15 years.
2. A nominee shall have worldwide academic recognition proving his/her contribution to the Cyber Systems and Engineering community.
3. Must be an IEEE SMC member (\$9) and IEEE TCCSE member (free, just claim to join), which can be joined at any time.
4. Help to recruit IEEE TCCSE members

Nomination Materials Submission for LCA:

A nominee or nominator must submit all materials in PDF format to the Chair of IEEE TCCSE via an email qiumeikang@yahoo.com Materials should include:

- First name, last name, affiliation, mail address, telephone, email.
- Contribution statement (up to 500 words, highlight academic achievements).

- A list of representative publications (up to 15 papers).
- Anything can prove nominee's research achievements.
- Anything benefits to recruit IEEE TCCSE members.
- A full academic CV (optional, recommend providing);
