The EiC's duties include identification of Associate Editors and Senior Editors to serve across the scope of the IEEE Transactions on SMC: Systems; management of the day-to-day operations of the journal through Scholar One Manuscripts with the assistance of the SMCS Publications Committee; monitoring of quality and timeliness of publications; identification of areas that require strengthening; and working with the Society and its Technical Committees to achieve these goals. The candidate should be a Fellow (or a Senior member) of IEEE, and an internationally recognized leading scholar in the fields of research of SMC, with extensive editorial experience, and strong leadership.

The EiC will report to the Society's Vice President for Publications. She/he is expected to participate in SMC Annual conference, Publications Committee meetings, and contribute to decisions about publication policies and priorities.

Criteria for Nominees:

High ethical standards with integrity;
Well-recognized in SMCS' fields of interests;
Extensive editorial experience;
Strong leadership experience and solid management skills;
Be a member of IEEE and SMCS; and
Preferably published articles in the IEEE Transactions on SMC: Systems.

Requirements for Nominations:

The nominees need to provide the following documents:

IEEE style biography (up to 250 words); Complete CV with publication list; Supporting letter from the nominator; and Vision statement for the IEEE Transactions on SMC: Systems (up to 200 words).

Self-nomination is permitted and encouraged.
